Attached Conditions for Hitch Offset Exemption for Movement of Recreational Trailers

Hitch Offset for Trucks Hauling Recreational Travel Trailers

This permit applies only to trucks that are towing a recreational travel trailer

Conditions:

- 1. For travel trailers with a ball hitch only, truck hitch offset shall not exceed 1.8 metres.
- 2. For travel trailers with a ball hitch combined with a weight distributing hitch, the truck hitch offset shall not exceed 4.90 metres; and
- 3. For travel trailers with a 5th wheel hitch, the truck hitch offset shall not exceed 4.90 metres.
- 4. The travel trailer in tow must be on its own running gear.
- 5. The truck must tow only one trailer.
- 6. The truck may carry a travel trailer on its deck while towing a travel trailer.
